How do I reserve the pass?

It can be reserved in person at the library at 318 Kearny Avenue or by telephone at 201-998-2666.

Is there a charge to reserve a pass?

There is no charge to reserve the museum pass but you must leave a **\$40.00 cash deposit when you pick up the pass**. The deposit will be refunded when the pass is returned **ON TIME**. If the pass is not returned **ON TIME**, a **fine of \$10 per day** will be charged. If the pass is stolen or lost, **the patron assumes the responsibility for the entire cost of the pass, which varies depending on the pass**.

Who can reserve a pass?

You must live or work in Kearny and have a Kearny Library card in good standing to place a reservation. The pass can only be reserved with an adult card by an adult over 18 years of age. A pass cannot be reserved with a child's card.

How many people are admitted to a museum per pass?

It depends on the pass. Check at the desk for more information

What is the "Day of Use"?

Day of use is the day you plan on visiting the museum. The pass can be picked up beginning at noon the day prior to the "Day of Use" and **MUST** be returned by 11:00 a.m. the day after the "Day of Use."

Can I cancel my reservations?

Reservations can be cancelled. Please let the library know of a cancellation as soon as possible since others may want to use the museum pass for that day.

Where do I pick up my pass?

The pass must be picked up at the Kearny Public library at 318 Kearny Avenue at the Main Desk no earlier than noon prior to the "Day of Use." (Check library schedule for prior open day, e.g., prior day for Monday may be Friday or Saturday, depending if the library is open on Saturday that week).

Do I need my library card to pick up the pass?

Yes, you **MUST** present the library card that you used when reserving the pass to pick it up.

Where do I return my pass?

The pass must be returned to the Main Desk (**DO NOT PUT IN BOOKDROP**) by 11 a.m. after the Day of Use. If the library is closed (for example on Saturdays in the summer), the pass must be returned by 11 a.m. on the next day the library is open.
